- A basic wall mount and common hardware is included with each of the boards.
- Installation should follow the recommended installation instructions provided by newline.
- The installation contractor is responsible for the secure mounting of each interactive panel in predetermined locations by the school district.
  - o A General building map will be provided indicating what size panel goes into the designated room.
- Installation locations will have a mix of wall structures including but not limited to drywall, concrete block, or overtop of an existing white board/chalk board.
- The installation contractor is responsible for any additional mounting hardware or supports necessary for secure mounting. This may include brackets or mounts that circumvent the drilling through existing white/chalk boards.
- The installation contractor is responsible for communicating any safety concerns to the district on the mounting location of each interactive panel.
- The installation contractor is responsible for the careful uninstall of any existing short throw projectors or interactive displays that exist in locations of the new interactive panels. The removed equipment may be reused throughout the district. The district will be responsible for the relocation or disposal of the existing equipment
- The installation contractor must make arrangements with the district to install the interactive panels without interruption to the educational day. This may include working before/after the school hours or on non-instructional days.
