Review your transcript for accuracy. Read and com- plete the Transcript Release Form found on the NASH School Counseling site. Complete the student portion of your applications and submit when they are completed. You do not have to wait for letters of rec or transcripts to submit.	You can begin to complete the FAFSA in December of your senior year.	Attend Financial Aid Night presentation at NASH.
Explore the scholarship list on Naviance and apply for any scholarships that fit you.	Visit the schools to which you have been accepted. A lot of places offer Accepted Student Days. Talk to recruiters if interested in military options.	Make your post high school choice. If it's college, compare your school acceptance offers to determine the best fit for you academically and financially.
Register, prepare for, and take any AP tests relevant to your schedule.	For college, send in your tuition deposit to your school of choice by May 1.	Complete the NA graduation survey found on Naviance. If you are attending college, you MUST mark which school is to receive your final transcript.
